

Men & Mice Suite 5.0.3 Delta Manual

This document summarizes the new or changed features in the Men & Mice Suite since the initial 5.0 release. At this writing, the current version of the Men & Mice Suite is 5.0.3

5.0.3 update information

Version 5.0.3 is a maintenance release, issued to resolve issues reported with the 5.0.1 release, and to add various feature enhancements.

RADIUS Support

Version 5.0.3 adds support for user authentication using RADIUS. To enable RADIUS authentication, you must add several properties to the Men & Mice Central configuration file **preferences.cfg**. This file is located in the **data** folder inside the Men & Mice Central folder.

RADIUSServer	Defines the address of the RADIUS server that will do RADIUS authentication.
RADIUSPort	Defines the port that the RADIUS server is listening on. The default value is 1812, which is the port normally used by RADIUS.
RADIUSSharedSecret	The shared secret between the RADIUS server and Men & Mice Suite.
RADIUSAuthentication	The type of authentication used. 0 = PAP, 1 = CHAP.

Example:

```
< RADIUSServer value="192.168.1.3"/>  
< RADIUSPort value="1515"/>  
< RADIUSSharedSecret value="MyBigSecret"/>  
< RADIUSAuthentication value="1"/>
```

Creation of AD Integrated Zones

It is now possible to create AD integrated zones. An AD integrated zone is created like any other zone, except that you click the **AD Integrated zone** checkbox in the zone creation dialog box.

Note: You can create AD integrated stub and forward zones as well as master zones.

Support for NAPTR Records

Support for the NAPTR record type has been added in version 5.0.3. An NAPTR record is created just like any other resource record in the Men & Mice Management Console.

Note: It is not possible to create NAPTR records using the Web interface.

Mac OS X Version of Men & Mice Management Console

Version 5.0.3 introduces the Mac OS X version of the Men & Mice Management Console.

5.0.2 update information

Version 5.0.2 introduced the .NET version of the Men & Mice Suite Web Interface. No other changes were introduced in version 5.0.2

5.0.1 update information

Version 5.0.1 was a maintenance release, issued to resolve issues reported with the initial release of 5.0, and to add various feature enhancements.

Enhanced Dialog Box for Zone Creation

It is now possible to select or deselect all servers by right-clicking the list of slave servers in the dialog box for creation of master zones and selecting the appropriate menu item.

Deletion of DHCP Leases

It is now possible to delete active DHCP leases. To delete an active DHCP lease, open the scope containing the lease, right-click the lease you want to delete, and choose **Delete**.

Manager Window Enhancement

The Manager Window now contains standard windows management controls and can be closed, minimized and maximized.

Scope Window Enhancement

The Scope Window now contains standard windows management controls and can be closed, minimized and maximized.
